Before: Long before the event

- Write 1-3 paragraphs telling what things were like LONG BEFORE your topic.
- Add at least one image to this area
- Add at least one quote to this area

Before: Right before the event

- Write 1-3 paragraphs telling what things were like RIGHT BEFORE your topic.
- Add at least one image to this area
- Add at least one quote to this area

Thesis statement here

Type and enlarge your thesis. Your thesis statement is a few sentences explaining what your topic is about and telling why it is important.

Be sure to connect your thesis to the yearly theme!
Turning Point: Why do you think this event is a turning point in history?

During: What happened during the event.

- Write 1-3 paragraphs telling what things were like AS your topic was happening.
- Add at least one image to this area
- Add at least one quote to this area

Right after: What happened right after the event. (hours, days, weeks or months after)

- Write 1-3 paragraphs telling what things were like RIGHT AFTER your topic happened.
- Add at least one image to this area
- Add at least one quote to this area

Long after: Why is the event still important today?

- Write 1-3 paragraphs telling what things were like LONG/AFTER your topic.
- Add at least one image to this area
- Add at least one quote to this area

Rules: 500 of your own words (quotes don't count so you can add a lot!) No plagiarizing!
